KANTOLOMBA VILLAGE PROJECT

The Kantolomba Village School project in Zambia was launched in 2009 by Swan Christian College with the construction of two classrooms and the sponsorship of 71 children. Swan Christian College has a commitment to helping the children of Kantolomba Village by providing food and quality Christian education. Many of the children who live in Kantolomba are orphaned due to the HIV virus and are raised by an older sibling or a grandparent. They are malnourished, uneducated and lack many of the basic necessities that we take for granted.

Through fundraising projects and the generous support of individuals we can continue the expansion of the Kantolomba school with more classrooms, staff and infrastructure. Further child sponsors will also provide the opportunity for more children to be blessed. Through schooling and nutritional meals our hope is that the children of Kantolomba Village will find a way of escaping the poverty cycle.

This November our third mission's team of staff and students from Swan Christian College will visit Kantolomba School, assisting with education, feeding programs and helping with the construction of further buildings. The team will also gather profiles and photographs of children to be sponsored to participate in the 2011 program.

Child sponsorship involves a direct debit of \$75 every three months, which will provide your child with schooling, meals and some basic healthcare. You will be given a profile about your child plus an opportunity to write and send gifts to them on a regular basis.
