Acceptable shoes for boys and girls must be sturdy material, offer adequate support and cover the entire upper section of the foot for protection. They should be:

- black leather
- lace up school design
- heeled up to 35mm

Please consult the College if you have any concerns about the acceptability of shoes you are intending to purchase as unacceptable shoes will need to be replaced.

Acceptable boys shoe examples



Unacceptable shoes for boys include:

- black leather slip-on
- pointed or long angular toe
- black runners / sport
- canvas
- boot style
- Velcro fastened
- have coloured stitching
- Vans style shoes

Acceptable girls shoe examples



Unacceptable shoes for girls include:

- thin soled slip-on
- laced 'ballet'
- flat thin soled
- no heel
- black runners / sport
- canvas
- boot style
- Velcro fastened
- have coloured stitching
