



New Midland Station Temporary Bus Interchange



To allow for construction of the permanent bus interchange as part of the New Midland Station Project, the existing bus interchange will close. A temporary bus interchange will open on Sunday, 11 May.

The temporary bus interchange will be located in front of the current Midland Station on the site of the former car park.

Services will continue without interruption, but some timetables will be slightly adjusted to allow for additional walking time; however, these changes are not expected to take effect on the first day.


Vehicle (including taxis) pick-up and drop-off is available inside the new multi-storey car park on Victoria Street.

The trees need to be removed to enable the new permanent bus interchange to be built as per the approved design.


Where will the permanent bus Interchange be located?
